
After the introductory speech and welcome address, Ms. Varsha Aher, Faculty, Dept. of English introduced invited speaker to the audience.

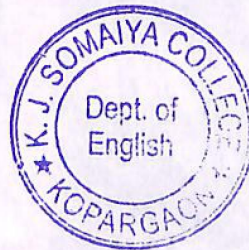
After the guest lecture, interaction session was held in which students asked their doubts and the guest cleared them.

Dr. R.A. Jadhav, Department of Commerce and Management, proposed the vote of thanks.



After then he focused on “**Career Opportunity for students in Green Power/ Energy and Manufacturing of Solar Power Equipment**”. He emphasize on PG diploma courses in Renewable Energy by IISE, Mumbai; M. Tech. Energy studies for M. Sc. Physics by TERI, School of Energy Studies Pune, Indore; MBA in Renewable Energy Symbiosis and MIT, Pune; M.Sc. in Sustainable Energy, UK; M.Sc. in Environment & Waste Management, Glasgow; Short Term online courses by Kwatt Solutions P. Ltd. Mumbai and Ph. D. in Solar Materials, Fuel Cells, Hydrogen, storage systems, etc. Also, he focused on Preparation and manufacturing of solar cell, which can reliant the nation and India can become a strong country for solar power.

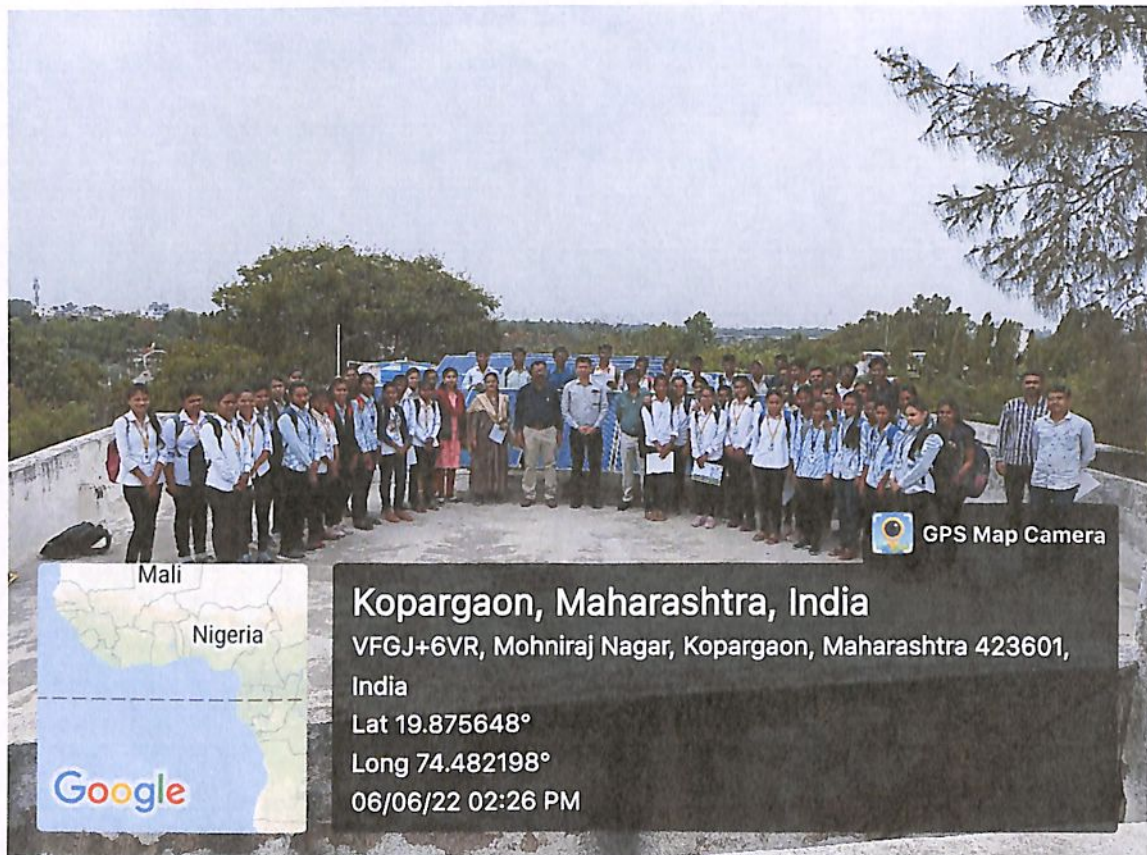




81 Students and 10 Faculty Members were participated in this One Day State Level Workshop. And 81 students took Member-ship of MASMA.

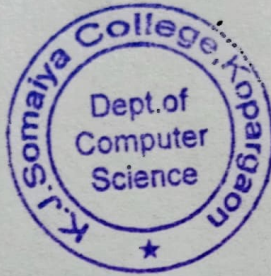



In the second, session Prof. Dr. Manojkumar Langote covered keywords, operators, some input output function and control statements with practice problems.


