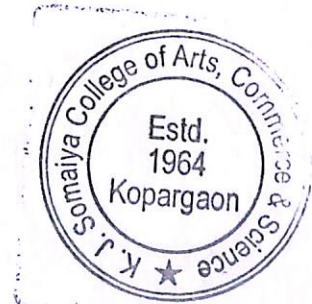

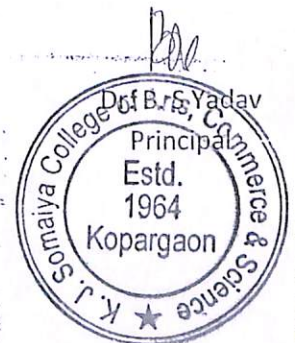

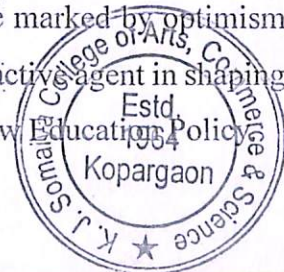
#### Session 1:
